ORDINANCE NO. 19-16
ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 21-2-6 OF ARTICLE II CHAPTER 21 LIQUOR
OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SULLIVAN,
MOULTRIE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City of Sullivan has deemed it advisable to allow Class A, B & C liquor license holders to occasionally host events at off site locations, not otherwise prohibited by law, rather than at the premises specified in their City issued license

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Sullivan, Illinois as follows

Section 1 CHAPTER 21-LIQUOR, ARTICLE II-LICENSES, SECTION 21-2-6 CLASSIFICATION-FEE-LIMITATION shall be amended to read as follows

The following paragraph shall be relocated to the end of Section 21-2-6 thereby following rather than preceding Subsection (E) Class "E" License and shall henceforth read as follows

The term "**premises specified**", as used in this Section, means the premises as particularly described in the application and license, and is limited thereto. A separate license for each separate location or place of business is required. Only one location shall be described in each license. An exception to this provision shall be that a special permit may be issued by the Liquor Control Commissioner to allow said licensee for a period not exceeding **twenty-four (24) hours** to sell those alcoholic liquors authorized by its license at a location within the City limits apart from the premises listed in said license

Section 2 All previous ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3 The provisions and sections of this ordinance shall be deemed separable and the invalidity of any portion of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of the remainder

Section 4 This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance No 19-16

Section 5 This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication as required by law
