Sullivan Residents Can Now Receive Real Time Public Safety Messages Through Nixle.

Sullivan, Illinois – The Sullivan Police Department has partnered with Nixle to implement its Community Notification System to alert residents in real – time for localized emergency situations and relevant community advisories.

As a resident, there are several simple ways to register:

1. Text your ZIPCODE to 888777 from your mobile phone.

Once registered, residents will receive a confirmation text to their mobile device. Residents may also customize their alert settings by going to [www.nixle.com](http://www.nixle.com) and creating a User Profile.

All Alerts will be targeted geographically, allowing residents to receive localized, relevant alerts from Sullivan Police Department.
