

PUBLIC HEARING OF THE SULLIVAN CITY COUNCIL

A Public Hearing of the Sullivan City Council will be held Monday, September 10, 2018, at 6:45 p.m. at the Elizabeth Titus Memorial Library, 2 West Water Street, in Sullivan.

The City of Sullivan has substantially completed the scope of work associated with a Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) funded public infrastructure grant used to construct targeted sanitary sewer system improvements in the City of Sullivan (Moultrie County). The grant was awarded and administered by the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO). Accordingly, a notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held on Monday, September 10, 2018 at 6:45 p.m. at the Elizabeth Titus Memorial Library, 2 West Water St, Sullivan, IL 61951.
